

All NEMO Committee Press Release: 16th October 2025

All NEMO Committee optimizes governance framework and reappoints Chairman

On 9th October 2025 the All NEMO Committee unanimously approved its current Chairman's, Rafael Gómez-Elvira González, reappointment for a period of one year until October 2026. 'I would like to express my sincere gratitude to all NEMOs for having entrusted me with helping to improve our Market Coupling Operation (MCO) governance. It is essential that we build on the knowledge and experience gained in decades of reliable operations of energy markets across Europe. We are committed to ensuring a future-proof SDAC and SIDC which support the EU in meeting its decarbonization and competitiveness challenges'- the newly reappointed All NEMO Committee Chairman said.

In the context of the ongoing revision of the CACM Regulation, the extension of the Chairman's mandate comes at a time when cooperation and coordination among NEMOs is paramount to overcoming challenges in an increasingly complex regulatory landscape, while driving forward future projects. The NEMOs are also pleased to announce the concrete steps they have taken to help the already well-functioning European internal energy market meet new needs and improve and adapt to changing times. In this light, NEMOs have gone beyond advocacy to implement, on a voluntary basis, some of the following building blocks:

- simplification of the contractual framework by merging the three NEMO- only contracts, i.e. All NEMO Cooperation Agreement, the All NEMO Day-ahead Operational Agreement and the All NEMO Intraday Operational Agreement under one contract: the All NEMO Cooperation Agreement 4th Amendment. This development aims at improving decision-making processes and streamlining the organization of workstreams;
- governance improvement through:
 - consolidation of the various NEMO governance bodies under the All NEMO
 Committee
 - o introduction of the **Qualified Majority Vote (QMV)**, which will speed up decision making and avoid escalation to authorities.

Other NEMO proposals for improvements and the **Annual Work Program 2026** will be shared with stakeholders in the coming weeks, in order to give more visibility, speed and certainty on next developments.

The All NEMO Committee facilitates the cooperation among NEMOs for all common European tasks necessary for the efficient and secure design, implementation and operation of single day-ahead and intraday coupling. The All NEMO Committee is formed by the appointed representatives of each NEMO.
