DECISIONS

NEMO GOVERNANCE

- NEMOs discussed the restart of the process of the CACM update and triggered the internal work to identify priority topics for NEMOs. NEMOs will remain active and are committed to cooperate with the European Commission during the CACM update.
- In order to have a better and more efficient coordination across all level of NEMO Cooperation, NEMO Committee introduced a dedicated NEMO Coordination Group, that consists of all Task force leaders across all levels of NEMO projects (NEMO Committee, NEMO DA Project and NEMO ID Project).

JOINT GOVERNANCE

- The NEMO vote on the proposed decisions within the agenda of the MCSC meetings was pre-aligned by the All NEMOs Committee, which ensured the efficiency of the MCSC meetings.

CO-OPTIMISATION

- Experts from individual NEMOs continue in close cooperation with ACER in clarifications related to co-optimisation and inclusion of its principles into the Algorithm methodology. ACER held a dedicated WS where NEMO experts and NEMO Committee's Tech Task Force leader were present.

PRODUCT METHODOLOGIES

- NEMO Committee held a consultation on the updated proposal for SDAC Product methodology (between 5th February and 4th March), five feedbacks and ACER's opinion were received, which, in general, supported NEMOs proposals for update. NEMO Committee is finalising the update of the methodology and it is expected that it will be formally submitted to ACER by the end of April.
- NEMO Committee also triggered the work on regular review of the SIDC Product methodology. The proposal shall be finalised by the end of April, dedicated consultation will follow.

SECOND AUCTION REMOVAL

- NEMOs cooperating within SDAC continued discussion on the potential removal of Second Auctions. Dedicated report from the consultation as well as answers to frequently asked questions (FAQs) received during the consultation were prepared and published on the NEMO Committee website.
- NEMOs also addressed the intention of removal of the Second Auctions directly with Market Participants, on the level of the Market Coupling Coordination Group (MCCG), as well as bilaterally with Baltic NRAs.

INTRADAY AUCTIONS

- NEMO Committee is regularly updated on the testing of the Intraday auctions, risks and proposed mitigation measures, that shall secure that the agreed Go-Live date of the Intraday auctions is fulfilled.

PROJECT PRIORITISATION

- NEMO Committee continued in the clarification with ACER regarding prioritisation of the projects for the period of 2025-2027, in order to align on the long term planning, taking into consideration of the regulatory deadlines. The clarification continues and is aimed to be closed at the MESC meeting in June.

CACM ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2023

- NEMO Committee has triggered the work on preparing the CACM Annual Report for 2023, that shall cover the development and operation of the SDAC and SIDC in 2023. NEMOs will closely cooperate with TSOs in finalisation of the report and will publish it within the deadline, set by the Algorithm methodology.

EXTERNAL COMMUNICATION

- NEMO Committee continues to be active in the Drafting Committee for Network Code Demand Response and closely aligns its position with Europex.
