DECISIONS

NEMO GOVERNANCE

- NEMO Committee continued voicing NEMOs opinion regarding the proposed text of revised CACM and cooperated with their Member States, where requested.
- In order to evaluate and improve the cooperation with DA and ID service providers, NEMO Committee has initiated a survey on the satisfaction with the service providers. The outcomes will be discussed with the providers and taken into account during discussion on long-term evolution of the DA and ID algorithms.
- NEMOs continue active clarification with ACER regarding REMIT Implementation legislation, a dedicated call was held to clarify the planned reporting.

JOINT GOVERNANCE

- The NEMO vote on the proposed decisions within the agenda of the MCSC meetings was pre-aligned by the All NEMO Committee, which ensured the efficiency of the MCSC meetings.

METHODOLOGIES

- Due to the triggering of the thresholds in the Harmonised Maximum and Minimum Clearing Prices methodology, the Harmonised Minimum Clearing Price for SDAC was set to -600 EUR/MWh, starting from 28th May (trading day).
- NEMO Committee launched two public consultations – on SDAC Product Methodology and Algorithm methodology.
 - The consultation on SDAC Product Methodology was held from 18th May to 18th June as a regular check that the available products reflect Market Participants' needs.
 - Consultation on Algo methodology was held from 13th May till 12th June related to anticipated timing adjustments to the Intraday Auctions due to the introduction of the Flow-based implementation.

SIGNIFICANT UPDATES IN DAY-AHEAD OPERATION

- NEMOs and TSOs are actively cooperating with ACER in order to minimise impacts of potential decoupling events and are discussing improvements of the system, two dedicated workshops were held, where NEMOs and TSOs presented their plans for improvement and also informed ACER on already taken actions.

NEMOs and TSOs made the necessary preparations for the successful go live of Advanced Hybrid Coupling on 10th June.

SIGNIFICANT UPDATES IN INTRADAY OPERATION

- On 11th June, the new release of the XBID System, with significant updates on performance, went live. The first days of operation after the Go-live confirmed the improvements in performance.
- In parallel, NEMOs and TSOs still continue the discussion on the mitigation and Corrective Measures, which shall be applied in case the SIDC system performance degrades. NEMO Committee is also continuing clarifications with external legal specialists, who shall perform additional impact analysis of the potential Corrective Measures.
- NEMOs and the ID Service Provider are also continuing the discussion on future development and other performance improvements.
- NEMOs are also continuing strategic discussions with the Service Providers about the future of DA and ID algorithms.

MCO INTEGRATION PLAN

- After alignment with ACER, NEMOs have finalised the updated MCO Integration Plan for the adherence of EnC Contracting Parties to SDAC and SIDC and submitted it to ACER on 16th June 2026.
- In parallel, NEMOs are active on the level of Joint Expert Team on Energy Community and are closely monitoring the transposition of Electricity Integration Package (EIP) in Energy Community Contracting Parties.

EXTERNAL COMMUNICATION

- NEMO Committee was represented in the EMIF (13th May), CACM PCG meeting (26th May), Florence Forum (28th and 29th May), Athens Forum (3rd and 4th June) as well as at the MESC meeting (11th June).
- NEMO Committee has finalised the work on CACM Annual report for 2025 and continues with planning of dedicated 4th NEMO Committee Annual Conference, that will be held in September 2026. NEMOs and TSOs (ENTSO-E) have also prepared and approved the CACM Cost Report for 2025. Both reports were by 1st July, as requested by the Algorithm methodology and by CACM respectively.
